

CALL FOR POSTERS

The **first edition of NanoInnovation 2016**, organized following the success of **NanotechItaly2015** and **NanoItaly 2015**, will be held from September 20th to 23rd in Rome, at the Sangallo Renaissance cloister of the Faculty of Civil and Industrial Engineering of "Sapienza" University of Rome.

NanoInnovation 2016 is jointly organized by **NanoItaly Association** and **AIRI - Italian Association for Industrial Research**, in collaboration with the most important companies, research organizations and institutions active at national level in the field of nanotechnology and the other Key Enabling Technologies (KETs).

The conference aims to represent **the national event of reference** for the wide, multidisciplinary international community involved in the study of nanotechnology and their integration with other KETs in all possible fields of application.

The three-day program is strongly oriented to stress the **applied aspects of nanotechnology** and other Key Enabling Technologies. Leading **organizations and speakers** from academia and industry, both Italian and international, will contribute to the event.

Applications must be submitted online by August 5th 2016, and the poster will have to be prepared following the submission guideline available online.

Contributions should address scientific and industrial developments in **application sectors relevant for nanotechnologies and their integration with KETs** including:

AERONAUTICS & SPACE; AGRI-FOOD; BIO-INSPIRED & BIO-BASED TECHNOLOGIES; BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION; CULTURAL HERITAGE; ENERGY; ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; ETHICS AND SOCIETAL IMPACTS; HEALTHCARE & NANOMEDICINE; ICT & NANOELECTRONICS; NANO-MATERIALS BASED INNOVATION; NANOMETROLOGY AND NANOSCALE MEASUREMENTS; NANOTOXICOLOGY & SAFETY; RISK MANAGEMENT and SMART MANUFACTURING & NANOFABRICATION.

Presentation of a poster requires a fee of 100 euro + VAT, to be paid, only in case of acceptance of the submitted abstract, before the beginning of NanoInnovation 2016. The corresponding invoice will be sent to the address indicated in the poster online form.

Selection of contributions will be based on their compliance with the conference themes and objectives.

A limited number of posters might be selected also for an oral presentation. Authors will be contacted in due time and asked to accept or refuse the proposal.

Posters by universities, research centers and businesses, will be displayed in the exhibition area of the conference.
