

## POSTER SUBMISSION: INSTRUCTIONS & GUIDELINE

The abstract of your planned contribution have to be prepared with the aim to describe your research and innovation activities and results and attract the audience of the event. The role of nanotechnologies and their integration with KETs in research and innovation, as well as potential/actual application areas must be highlighted within the abstract.

- Contribution must be of technical-scientific nature. Promotional material will be rejected.
- Prepare your abstract (only plain text) with a maximum of 2000 characters (including blanks).
- Submit your abstract online at <http://www.nanoinnovation.eu>, within the deadline reported in the NanoInnovation website. The procedure requires the registration of the submitting author.
- Abstracts will be selected by the Conference Committees, basing on compliance with conference themes and objectives
- Late submissions might be refused due to limitation in the exhibition space.
- Acceptance will be communicated to authors within the deadline reported in the NanoInnovation website.
- Once you will receive the notification regarding acceptance of your contribution please register to the Conference following the online procedure on the Conference website.
- Presentation of a poster requires a registration fee of 100 euro + VAT. The corresponding invoice will be sent to the address indicated in the poster online form.
- A limited number of posters might be selected also for an oral presentation. Authors will be contacted in due time and asked to accept or refuse the proposal.
- Posters will be displayed in the main Conference Hall (same place of coffee breaks, lunches and exhibition)
- Poster sessions will be open all the day during the event. Coffee breaks, lunch and end of the oral sessions it is when most of delegates will likely visit the poster area. Authors are free to decide whether and when to be present at the poster stand.
- The poster must be in English, have the following dimensions: 90 cm (width) x 120 cm (height) and prepared according to the template that will be sent will the notification of acceptance.
- The authors are responsible to bring and place their poster on the stand at the beginning of the Conference and to remove it at the end of the event
- The abstracts of the poster contribution will be uploaded on the NanoInnovation website.
