

Andrea Zappettini has a degree in Physics and a master in Material Science. After working for Eni and Pirelli, he is now senior researcher at Istituto Materiali for Elettronica e Magnetismo (IMEM), an Institute of the Italian National Research Council (CNR). At IMEM, he is Head of the Signal group, mainly devoted to the development of sensors based on novel and multifunctional materials. He is author of 185 scientific papers on international journals, cited more than 2100 times, h-index 25 (source Scopus). He is also author of 12 International patents and 5 National patents. Since 2011 he is Chair of the Commission for Crystal Growth and Characterization of Material of International Union of Crystallography and member of the Executive Committee of International Organization for Crystal Growth. Since 2014 he is also Chair of the Crystal Growth Section of the Italian Crystallography Association.
