

Gian graduated at the University La Sapienza in the academic year 1999-2000 with a thesis on mathematical modeling of neurons (Physics department). Between 2001 and 2005 he carried out the doctoral studies at the University of Zurich CH (Biochemistry department) focusing on the folding and misfolding of proteins associated with neurodegenerative disorders. As an associate researcher, Gian worked at the University of Cambridge UK (Chemistry and Genetics departments) under the supervision of Chris Dobson and Michele Vendruscolo. In the period 2005-2010, he participated in several computational and experimental studies on amyloidosis. Gian started his laboratory at the Centre for Genomic Regulation in 2010 (Barcelona, Spain) and was tenured as professor of Institució Catalana de Recerca i Estudis Avançats ICREA in 2014.
