

Corrado Di Natale is a full professor of Electronics at the Department of Electronic Engineering of the University of Rome Tor Vergata where he teaches courses on electronic devices and sensors. His research activity is concerned with the development and application of chemical and bio-sensors, artificial sensorial systems (olfaction and taste), and the optical and electronic properties of organic and molecular materials. He authored more than 450 papers on international journals and conference proceedings (H-index=53, Scopus). He is the current president of the International Society on Olfaction and Electronic Nose and serves as editorial board member of the journals Scientific Reports (Springer-Nature) and Sensors (MDPI).
