Prof. Gianluigi Casse, director of the Centre for Material and Mycrosystems of the Fondazione Bruno Kessler (FBK-CMM) is an experimental physicist active in elementary particle experiments. He is part of the LHCb Experiment at CERN, and has contributed to the design of the ATLAS and LHCb detectors and their upgrades (currently in progress). He is the Spokes-person of the CERN/RD50 experiment at CERN, aimed at the development of highly radiation tolerant instrumentation for future high energy physics experiments.

He holds a chair of experimental physics in the University of Liverpool.
