Hilton B. de Aguiar holds a PhD from EPFL/Lausanne (Switzerland), jointly with the Max-Planck Institute/Stuttgart (Germany). His research activities span from soft matter physics to ultrafast nonlinear spectroscopy, with over 24 papers published. His PhD focused on applications of ultrafast vibrational spectroscopy for studies of colloidal interfaces.
